

## **ALASKA SEAFOOD PROCESSING LEADERSHIP INSTITUTE 2008 CALENDAR of TRAINING SESSIONS**

### **February 20-29 Anchorage and Study Tour to Boston area**

Introduction to the Alaska Seafood Processing Leadership Institute, expectations, working with your mentor; the basics of Alaska's seafood processing industry, the global marketplace for Alaska seafood, Alaska's seafood product forms now and in the future, assignments for study tour.

ASPLI participants then travel to the northeast and spend two days at the International Boston Seafood Show and two days touring a variety of seafood processing and reprocessing plants in the northeast.

### **March 25 - April 4 Kodiak**

This two week session will cover seafood processing technology: product forms, ensuring the quality and safety of products, handling, holding and shipping, processing techniques, monitoring production, ensuring safe working practices, hands-on management of a seafood plant. The session will take place at the UAF Fishery Industrial Technology Center.

### **September 29 - October 4 Anchorage**

The last week of ASPLI 2008 will allow participants to debrief after their processing employment. Focus will also be on leadership skills, regulatory issues, operations and human resources management, seafood logistics, and the future of Alaska's seafood industry.
